NURSE ASSISTANT (CNA)



The Nurse Assistant (CNA) program is a course leading to an entry level career in the health care industry. The course emphasizes care of the older adult client and assistance with the activities of daily living: bathing, dressing, exercise, movement, eating, eliminating safety measures and rehabilitation techniques. The Nurse Assistant Program also provides clinical instruction. Students will practice skills in lab and then be assigned to assist clients in a Skilled Nursing Facility.

Duration: (22 days) 7 Weeks, 176 Total Hours

Intended Audience: 18 years/or have a HS diploma, G.E.D or pass an Ability to Benefit Exam.



NOTE- Upon successfully completing the Nurse Assistant Program, the student will be enrolled to take the State Certificate Exam and must pass in order to become a CNA. *The state exam is now offered at our Turlock Campus.*
